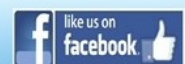

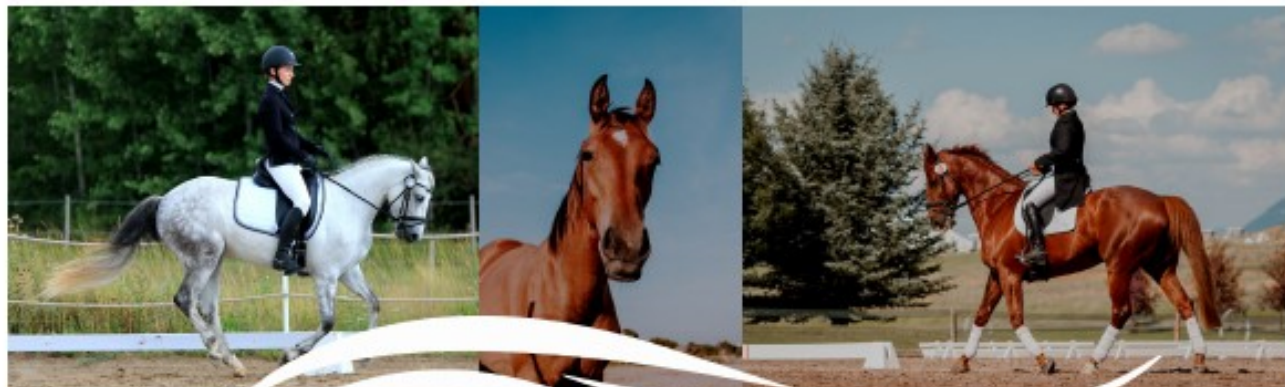

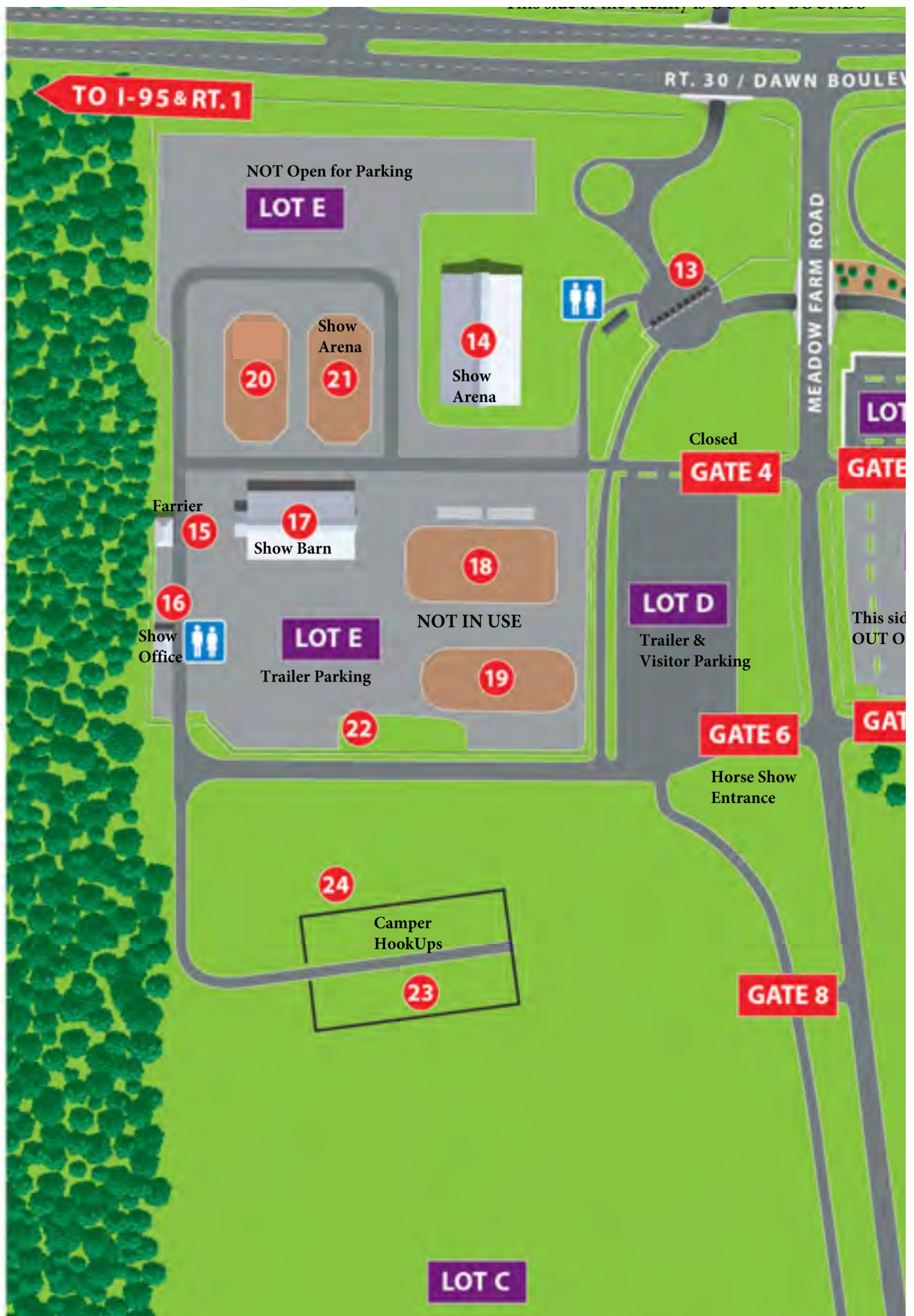

Virginia Dressage Association- Central Chapter Accident Preparedness Plan

Dressage at The Meadow – Doswell,VA

Safety Officer- Nancy Lowey 540.229.5422

Copy of plan sent by email or given to all officials and volunteers.

- Ring Steward/Judge or other Show Official immediately notifies office and Safety Officer of an accident by radio or in person.
- EMT- Chris Craft- has radio and is notified and leaves for the scene of the accident. He is on grounds from 1 hour before show starts and off grounds at conclusion of show.
- (Safety Team) Show Manager/Safety Coordinator, TD, Stable Manager, EMT and VET (if on grounds) immediately go to the scene of the accident. Vet will be called by show management if not on grounds.
- Announcer asks spectators to clear the area and NOT to call 911. The Announcer puts out a call to the 'Safety Team' listed above.
- Safety team keeps spectators away from injured rider/spectator.
- They make sure that the injured rider/spectator is not moved or does not move.
- They make sure someone takes control of the horse.
- EMT takes control of the situation.
- EMT determines the nature of the injured and the appropriate steps of action to take to insure the safety and well- being of the injured rider/spectator.
- EMT discusses planned actions with safety team and injured rider/spectator. If deemed necessary by EMT, Show Manager/Safety Coordinator or EMT will call 911. Only Show Manager/Safety Coordinator or EMT will place a 911 call and provide the emergency personnel with the correct location, i.e. facility location, directions and exact location of injured on property. This call should be placed over a land line to assist in determining location if possible.
- Request that sirens and lights be turned off upon entry to The Meadow to minimize frightening other horses and potentially causing another accident.
- Show Manager/Safety Coordinator disburses crowd, calms parents/spouse/children, checks condition of horse and what action needs to be taken for the horses well- being.
- Show Manager/Safety Coordinator will designate someone to be at The Meadow driveway entrance to guide the emergency vehicle to the scene of the accident.
- Show Manager/Safety Coordinator will make sure that there is a clear and safe pathway for the emergency vehicle to access the injured rider/spectator.

Accident Injury Report Form filled out by TD with verifying information by EMT.



Virginia Dressage Association -Central (VADA CC)

VADA -CC Rules, Guidelines, and Best Practices for its competitions at The Meadow Event Park under current social distancing and other Federal, State, and Local Requirements.

Updated February, 2021

This is a working-document for VADA- CC Specific protocol to ensure the safest environment possible for our competitions. We will continue to update this protocol as we receive updates and information from USEF, USDF and local authorities.

VADA CC 2021 COVID-19 Rules, Guidelines, and Best Practices

VADA -CC has prepared the following list of Rules, Guidelines, and Best Practices in preparation for the VADA- CC hosted 2021 competition. The objective of this document is to familiarize competitors/staff of COVID-19 protocol that must be adhered to at all VADA -CC hosted competitions. Failure to follow the guidelines may result in expulsion from the show grounds.

The VADA CC competition management has taken into consideration the size of The Meadow Event Park and the number of attendees, but have concentrated our efforts and protocol requirements in the areas that will cause the greatest challenges for social distancing - Show Office, Stabling Area, and Warm-up areas.

We believe these guidelines are well within our scope to institute and enforce during our competitions. We will update these guidelines as needed based on State and Local Government requirements and/or recommendations from other local environmental health and public health agencies. Updates will be posted at VADA - CC website www.vada-cc.org.

THE MEADOW EVENT PARK- – COVID-19 WELLNESS

1. Any person with known or suspected symptoms of COVID-19 or who has been exposed to a person with symptoms of COVID-19 (cough, shortness of breath, or fever) should follow self-quarantine protocol or will be barred from or removed from the grounds.
2. All Individuals should monitor their temperature daily, and should not enter the premises if presenting with a temperature of 100.4 or higher.
3. All individuals, including participants, VADA-CC competition staff, officials, and volunteers, **must** wear a mask or face covering while on the show grounds. The only exception is when mounted on a horse. If you have a medical/ADA issue, refer to the USEF Action Plan for the procedure to document your issue and receive USEF dispensation.
4. Upon entry into the horse park, the volunteer staff will request everyone to complete a health check questionnaire, sign a USEF wavier, have their temperature taken by a staff member. Please allow yourself ample time for this process. Arm bracelets will be given out and worn by all after this procedure.
5. All individuals should monitor their temperature daily, and should not enter the premises if presenting with a temperature of 100.4 or higher.
6. All competitors and support personnel are responsible for monitoring their own personal and family health prior too, during, and after attending a competition. If anyone who was present on the competition grounds test positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of the conclusion of the competition must notify VADA CC Safety Coordinator (Nancy Lowey. 540 229 5422) immediately.
7. The competition is only open to competitors, essential support personnel (e.g., owner, trainer, coach, parent, one groom/assistant), competition staff, officials, service providers, and volunteers. All support personnel associated with a horse must be listed on the entry form and sign the USEF waiver. NO other family members, relatives, friends are allowed on the show grounds.
8. Barn access is restricted to essential personnel associated with a horse, vets, braiders, night watch, Show Staff/Officials.
9. **NO SPECTATORS** will be allowed on the show grounds.

ARRIVAL AND CHECK-IN

1. Following your health assessment -including temperature, questionnaire, waiver and arm band bracelet- at the show entrance gate, proceed to the Packet pick up Tent for packet pick up. Stall assignment(s) will be listed on your packet and also on the Horse Show Office website. In the event an entry is not complete, contact Bettina Longaker (text/phone 540-222-5850) to set up an appointment to finalize entry after your health assessment. Please note the show office will not be open to competitors. *Appointment only.*
2. Official ride times will be posted on the HorseShowOffice.com horseshowoffice.com/ up. Stall assignments will be posted there also.
3. Class results are available on HorseShowOffice.com horseshowoffice.com/ and via text messaging. Note: To receive text messaging feature contact Bettina Longaker (text/phone 540-222-5850) for set-up assistance.

SHOW GROUNDS FACILITY

1. Practice social distancing (6' feet between individuals) at all times. Do not congregate.
2. Immediate Household Groups must be identified by filling out the Immediate Household Identification Form and receiving an identifying wristband. This will permit those individuals to be closer than 6 feet.
3. All individuals should frequently wash hands or use hand sanitizer with 60% alcohol. Hand washing and disinfection stations are available throughout the show grounds.
4. Restrooms, touchpoints, and common areas will be cleaned by personnel and sanitized throughout each day of the competition.

STABLING

1. VADA CC will arrange stabling so there is the appropriate social distance between trainer groups. Use only your entrance to your aisle to access your stalls. Do not enter aisles/stabling areas of other trainer groups.
2. All individuals must wear mask or face covering, maintain social distancing, and limit group size to ten (10).
3. Encourage handwashing or hand sanitization before entering the stabling area. Sanitization stations will be located throughout each barn.
4. Personnel will regularly clean and disinfect high contact areas in each barn throughout the day. Do your part to keep the barns clean and dispose of trash in receptacles.
5. Trainers are responsible for the conduct and adherence to the protocols for their clients and staff.
6. Groom and tack your horse in the stall. Not in the barn aisle. Mount and dismount outside the barn.

SCHOOLING AND WARM-UP RINGS

1. Competitors must check in with the ring steward and adhere to show protocols.
2. Schooling and warm-up rings will be monitored by a ring steward to ensure rings do not become overcrowded and social distancing practiced.
3. During competition hours, rings will be limited only to riders warming up for the upcoming class. Trainer and/or support personnel coaching a rider in the competition area must be mindful of practicing social distancing and other groups.
4. All individuals must wear a mask and/or face covering at all times on the show grounds unless mounted.

COMPETITION AND EQUIPMENT CHECKS

1. Show braiding is optional.
2. Readers must wear his/her mask to read the test to the competitor.
3. A Ring Steward will make a visual equipment check for a prescribed number of class competitors. There will be a designated whip measuring area located on the fence with tape defining the allowed whip length. If any questions arise regarding equipment checks, a TD will accompany the competitor back to the barn and/or a selected area to discuss the issue.

CLASS AWARDS/RIBBONS AND TESTS

1. **All tests** will be scanned in the show office and emailed on show day to each competitor
2. Class ribbons/prizes will be picked up in the designated Awards area on the show grounds.
3. Social distancing will be practiced with signs located at the entry to the awards area outlining social distancing requirements and test pick-up procedures. There will be social distance floor decals/tape defining the 6' separation.
4. A maximum of 10 individuals in line at one time practicing social distancing. If the number exceeds, individuals will be kindly asked to return at a later time.
5. Designated Awards area hours are 9:00 a.m. to 1 hour after the last class for the day.
6. Ribbons /prizes will not be mailed.
7. All individuals must wear a mask and/or face covering to pick up prizes, and ribbon.
8. Gloves are available to wear for picking up ribbon/prizes.
9. Awards tables will be regularly sanitized throughout the show.

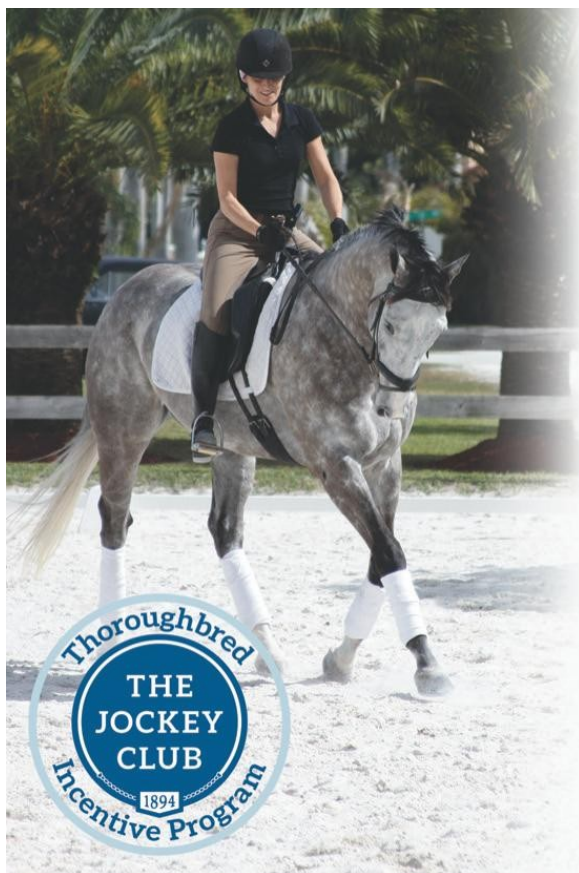

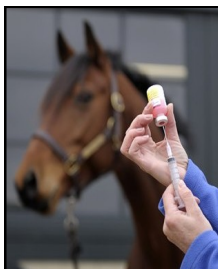

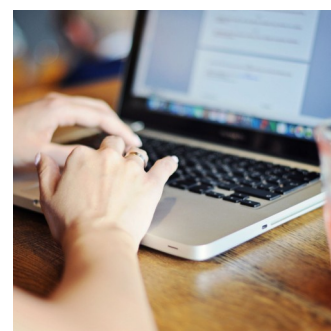

Regional Adult Amateur Equitation Program

The USDF Regional Adult Amateur Equitation Program recognizes adult amateurs competing in equitation and promotes correct seat, position, and use of the aids in dressage. An Adult Amateur Equitation Regional Final class presented by Big Dee's Tack and Vet Supply will be held in conjunction with each of the nine USDF Regional Dressage Championship competitions, providing adult amateurs with additional opportunity for recognition.

Adult amateurs wishing to qualify to compete in an Adult Amateur Equitation Regional Final may do so by meeting the following requirements.

Qualifying Requirements

To be eligible for the USDF Adult Amateur Equitation Regional Final class, rider must have

- Earned a score of 70% or higher in any dressage seat equitation class (except walk/trot) at a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Dressage competition within the qualifying period of the applicable regional championship.

or

- Qualified to compete in any regional dressage championship class (excluding freestyles).

Membership Requirements

- Rider must have a USDF Participating Membership at the time the qualifying score is earned, and at the time of the Regional Final class.
- Rider must be an adult amateur, in accordance with GR1306 of the USEF rules, and be designated with USEF as an adult amateur when the score is earned, and at the time of the Regional Final class.
- Owner must have a USDF Participating or Business Membership when the qualifying score is earned, and at the time of the Regional Final class.
- Horse must have a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration when the qualifying score is earned, and at the time of the Regional Final class.

2021 Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships

A single Regional Dressage Championship program organized by the United States Dressage Federation (USDF), and recognized by the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (USEF), will be held in each of the nine USDF regions. In addition, Alaska and Hawaii may each hold state championships if an official request from a Group Member Organization (GMO) is received by April 1 of the prior year. The Regional Championship Program Rules can be found on the USDF website at www.usdf.org. Please refer to the 2021 USDF Member Guide for the comprehensive list of rules and requirements for this program.

Membership/Registration Requirements for Qualifying and Championships

All memberships and registrations/recordings must be correct and current at the time qualifying scores are earned and at the time of the championships.

Rider:

- Must have a USDF Participating* Membership (PM).
- Must have a USEF membership (Junior Active, Senior Active, or Life).

Horse:

- Must have a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR).
- Must have a USEF (Annual or Lifetime) Horse recording.
- USDF horse registration and USEF horse recording must be in the name(s) of the current owner(s) or lessee(s).
A horse is not required to have breed registry papers.

Owner:

- Must have a USDF Participating or Business Membership and a USEF membership (Junior Active, Senior Active, Life, or Recorded Farm (with Active Farm Owner)). If the horse has more than one owner, at least one owner must have both active USEF membership and active USDF Participating or Business Membership and must be the owner of record with USEF and USDF. For a business or farm to be the valid owner under this requirement, it must be listed as an owner of the horse with both USEF and USDF.

* PMs are USDF members who join USDF directly. USDF Group Members (GM) are ineligible.

Minimum Qualifying Scores: One set of nationally-standardized qualifying scores has been established for all USEF/USDF Regional Championships, for Training Level through Grand Prix, in three divisions: open, adult amateur and junior/young rider. FEI Junior and FEI Young Rider classes have only one respective division. Freestyles have only open divisions.

Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct applicable numbers (USDF and USEF) for horse, owner, rider, and trainer, before the day(s) of the competition.

The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards.

MODIFIED DRESS CODE FOR RIDERS IN OPPORTUNITY CLASSES

Riders in classes and tests at all levels in Level 1 Competitions, and riders in Opportunity classes in Level 2 and Level 3 Competitions, may compete wearing breeches and shirts of any color as permitted in DR120.8. Jackets or vests of any type are allowed but not required and neckwear may be worn only if the rider chooses to compete in a riding jacket. Boots and protective headgear are required as specified in DR120.1-6. USEF DR120.5. **ACCORDINGLY, JACKETS ARE NOT REQUIRED FOR ANY RIDERS IN OPPORTUNITY CLASSES AT THE COMPETITION.**

USDF Statement on Animal Welfare

The United States Dressage Federation, Inc. (USDF), a federation of individual members and over 100 independent organizations throughout the United States, supports the concept of ethical treatment of animals.

Dressage is a classical method of training horses, based upon the horse's natural responses, as carried out in a gradual, planned program during which the horse's athletic abilities are improved in a systematic manner. As a result, the horse becomes capable, comfortable, and responsive in partnership with the rider without the use of force. Dressage competition at various levels of achievement is the ultimate test of the training program to determine whether the desired harmony between horse and rider has been achieved.

The rules pertaining to dressage competition prohibit the use of artificial appliances, training aids, and drugs, which would force the horse to submit. Instead, the emphasis is upon training and a cooperative partnership with the rider. Major competitions are carefully monitored to assure that there is no unnecessary force or harshness displayed.

Unlike other horse sports in which horses enter training at a relatively immature state, dressage training is usually not seriously begun until the horse is three or four. The top levels of achievement require five or more years of progressive training and it is not unusual to see horses in international competition in their late teens. This, in itself, places a premium on good care and soundness throughout the horse's life.

While supporting the concept of animal welfare in its broadest form, the United States Dressage Federation, Inc., also recognizes that it is unrealistic to ascribe human emotions and responses to the horse which in its wild state is a creature of flight, living a hard and precarious existence. Under domestication, the horse is assured of ample food, water, and shelter, as well as protection against infectious diseases and damaging parasites, thus leading a longer and healthier life with a high rate of survival.

As an educational organization, USDF has numerous programs, which teach people how to pursue the accepted, humane training methods. A program of certifying instructors also emphasizes protecting the horse's welfare in pursuit of dressage training.

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions: Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.)

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$90), 5-years (\$360), or life (\$1,800). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$72). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GM): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards Program and the USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program.

Business Membership (BM): A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$240) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$35 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$35). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded, but will NOT be counted towards Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$80. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$115) is eligible for Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

How to Join USDF

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

- In the show office at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions classified by USEF as Dressage Competitions, and Regular Competitions which are open to all breeds.

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day.

In accordance with GR1301.7: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.



USEF Membership Statement (GR901.9)

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes. 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.



The Equine Activity Liability laws of the State of Virginia, VA Code Ann. Sec 3.2-6200-6203 state among its statutory provisions that, "NOTICE: Intrinsic dangers in equine activity, include (i) the propensity of equines to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm, or death to persons on or around them; (ii) the unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement, and unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals; (iii) certain hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions; (iv) collisions with other animals or objects; and (v) the potential of a participant acting in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the equine or not acting within the participant's ability." No Participant nor any participant's parent, guardian, or representative shall have or make any claim against or recover from any equine activity sponsor, equine professional, or any other person for injury, loss, damage, or death of the participant resulting from any of the intrinsic dangers of equine activities. It is further understood that each owner, rider, spectator, and other participants assume any and all risks of loss or injury and agrees to hold harmless, regardless of negligent acts or omissions VADACC, Inc, The Meadow Event Park, USDF, USEF, its instructors, officers, directors, agents, show management, show committee, and all other horse show personnel.
